RE News: Lots of Year End Activities.

Though the competition seasons have pretty much completed, a lot of important off-track activity is taking place.

IRP Update: Pete Hylton, Steve Linn and Terrance Garrett met with IRP management regarding repairs to the track surface. Progress is being made and we hope to be able to report on IRP's plans soon. We are on the calendar for our double regional in May and the Indy Grand Prix National in July.

Area 4/Cendiv Update. I attended a meeting of Area 4 REs on October 17 in Ft Wayne. The following three key items were discussed:

Cendiv Regional Championship Series. Progress was made toward re-establishing a regional race series. The most significant change is to make this into an Area 4 series; I opposed this move, as I believe our regional race draws Area 5 drivers. A reconstituted series board is in the works; if anybody has an interest in serving in some role to support this series, please contact me ASAP. The new board will be developing a proposal for the new rules and much is open for discussion including what races should be included, whether or not drivers should have to sign up, and what car classes should be included.

Area 4, Inc. The next steps toward incorporation were taken. Articles of Incorporation and bylaws for Area 4 incorporation were reviewed and amended.

Cendiv Split. Prior to the meeting in Ft Wayne, Indy Region's BOD voted unanimously to not support a split of Cendiv. A number of factors at almost every level and from many angles were considered and input from members was taken into account. In Ft Wayne this was not discussed at length, however it became clearer that support for the split was not going to be as strong as perhaps once expected. Area 4 Director Erik Skirmants provided more insight into how he sees this unfolding. The next step for

this is Roundtable, where Area 4 RE's again plan to meet.

Indy Region BOD. The work of Indy Region doesn't get done by itself. People volunteer their time and effort. It's that time of year when plans for next year are being



put in place. SCCA may be out of sight and out of mind right now for you. I ask you to look ahead and help us to plan for the future. I could beg you to help. I could threaten that without your help the region will suffer. I could reason with you, saying that as a volunteer organization, people should feel obliged to volunteer at some point along the way. I'll just leave you with this: it's amazing how much of a difference one person can make.

Chuck Hansen is heading up the Nominating Committee for the '05 BOD. I hope that you will contact him to find out how you can get involved to make a difference in 2005.

Comp Program Help. In addition to BOD positions to fill, we also need help with the race, rally and solo programs. No experience necessary, will train on the job. Contact me, the current program chairperson, or any member of the BOD if you can lend a hand. As I've written and said before, you don't have to take on a huge role to make a difference. Every little bit helps.

Thanks and Farewell. LouAnn and Ian Linn are on their way to Florida permanently, leaving us missing their help in taking care of Indy Region business. LouAnn did a great job as Activities chairperson and Ian was our Membership dude. Beyond their assigned roles, both of them also helped out in various other roles, especially in the race program. Ian will be moving into the tough Florida racing scene in his Spec Miata. On behalf of Indy Region, we wish them luck and Godspeed in their move. On a related note, Steve and Jim are recruiting for replacements within the Lin(n) "family".

Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Activities. Lou Ann is leaving at the end of November. Right now, it looks like the banquet will cost \$21.95 per person. Ticket prices will be held at \$ 20.

Membership. Nothing has been received from National in two months. Matt will take over the Membership duties, since lan is also leaving.

AIM Tuning has volunteered to do the needed Solo. transmission & oil work on Da Bus. Darren is still working on the year-end trophies. Rick Swarts asked about doing another Divisional event again next year up at Grissom. He and Raleigh Boreen will run the event, and they are looking for an 'apprentice' to train to run the event in the future.

Rally. The Halloween rally is Saturday, October 23rd.

Race. Alyson is unable to take on the job of race chair next year, but would be willing to serve as a co-chair. There has been some significant and very positive discussion with IRP regarding track repair. IRP seems to be willing to work with the club to reach some sort of agreement. and is looking into a bid to repair sections of the track. Nothing is definite at this point, but looks favorable.

The discussions were amicable and friendly, but it is never going to happen.

> Matt gave an update on the Area 4 incorporation/ CenDiv split issue, and there was much discussion regarding both issues. The Board voted unanimously to oppose the split and support the incorporation of CenDiv, or incorporation of Area 4 as a last resort. Matt is to attend a meeting of RE's in Ft. Wayne October 17.

> November 5th and 6th is the CenDiv New Business. roundtable in Worthington, Ohio.

> Next meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, November 10th, tentatively at Fastimes.

Meeting was adjourned.

Club Elected and Appointed Office Descriptions

SCCA and from the National Office of the SCCA:

Duties of Regional Executive: The Regional Executive shall reside at all meetings of the members and directors, and shall perform the duties usually pertaining to this office. The R.E. is the Chief Executive and Official Spokesperson for the Region; prepares agendas, presides, and reports on the Region status at all meetings; signs and executes (with the Treasurer) all contracts, files all required reports, statements, and certificates; enforces the Bylaws and supervises all Region activities.

Duties of Assistant R.E.: Assists the R.E. with filings, Bylaw enforcement, and Region supervision. In absence of the Regional Executive, or in case of his resignation or inability to act, the duties usually pertaining to that office shall be performed by the Assistant Regional Executive.

Duties of Secretary: The secretary shall attend all meetings of the members and officers and shall record all minutes and votes in a book kept for that purpose; shall give all notices of meetings of the members required by law or these Bylaws and shall perform all duties incident to the office as may be required by the Board of Directors.

Compiled from the Bylaws of the Indianapolis Region Duties of the Treasurer: The Treasurer shall, subject to such conditions and restrictions as may be made by the directors, have custody of all moneys, debts, and obligations belonging to the corporation; shall receive all moneys of the corporation and deposit same in the corporation's account; shall make all payments of corporation debts; all contracts, checks, drafts, notes or other orders for payment of money shall be signed in the name of the corporation by the Treasurer; shall have custody of the corporate seal, and the records of the corporation; will report Region Financials at BOD meetings (including an Annual Report) and ensure preparation and filing of all tax information.

> Duties of the Activities Chairman: It shall be the duty of the Activities Chairman to arrange and promote all activities of the corporation and shall have other duties as may be prescribed from time to time by the Board of Directors.

> Duties of Membership Chairman: The Membership Chairman shall solicit, issue, and process all new membership applications. The Membership Chair will work closely with the Activities Chair in the recruitment and retention of members.

INVOLVED MEMBER AWARD description and points

The purpose of the Involved member award is to recog- Rally Events: nize Indy Region members who exhibit exceptional participation during the year. It is not a competition between members. In fact, the more award recipients the better. It is truly a celebration of dedication, support and commitment to Indy Region SCCA.

An Involved member award will be presented to each Indianapolis Region member, 16 years of age and older, who earns a minimum of 800 points in a calendar year by participating in at least two of the following four areas of participation: meetings and other club-sponsored special events, rally, race and solo.

An Involved member award will be presented to each Indianapolis Region junior member, under 16 years of age, Monthly meeting attendance who earns a minimum of 400 points in a calendar year by participating in at least two of the areas of participation.

The Involved member award will be an embroidered lightweight jacket or fleece. A member will be awarded a jacket only once in five years. A repeat award will be recognized by embroidering the award year on the jacket.

Points are only awarded for Indy Region events, Cendiv Roundtable, and SCCA National Convention. There will be no combination of points for a single event; points from only one category may be scored per day. For example, a member who is a worker and a driver on the same day at the same event may only score points for one category or the other.

Each member is solely responsible for tracking and reporting their points; no one else will do this for you. To be eligible for an award, the Indy Region member must fill out the form on next page or a reasonable facsimile and mail it to Matt Curry at 5023 TC Steele Lane, Carmel IN 46033. Or get the Excel file from the website, fill it in, and e-mail it to mc2fast@indy.rr.com. The form must be delivered no later than November 16 in order to receive the award at the annual awards banquet. All forms must be received no later than the next January 10 in order to be eligible for an Involved member award for the year. Confirming receipt of submitted points is the sole responsibility of the entrant. A person's eligibility will be verified by the Membership Chairman.

Thanks to Scott Dales, Matt Curry, Sean Murphy, and Jack Tovey, who were brave enough to lend ME their rides. Scott's Mini is amazing, Jack's S2000 is a pleasure to drive, Sean's Camaro is fun and more balanced than I would of thought, and Matt..... DAMN, THAT RX-7 IS LOUD!!!!! Not a scratch was left by me, but their tires are a different story.... Thank you all for the opportunity!

Found somewhere close to this column should be the trophy listing for the 2004 Indy Region Solo2 Series Championship. Congrats to all the winners, and your trophies will be distributed at the Saturday December 4th Year End Awards Banquet. Please join us, and don't forget to get in your reservation for a memorable evening! The rules dictating trophy awards are available on the website, and in the March Clutch Chatter.

Also found in the nearby pages would be the tabulation for the 2004 Indy Region Jack Tovey Solo2 Champion of the Year awards, and congratulations are to be extended to Matt Curry, who won out by only 10 points, from a maximum total of 600 points. Matt is always a tough competitor, and stayed tough even while changing a few rides and classes during the year. Newcomer Waylen Hunsucker took second in that ranking, showing his skill – and booting me out of that spot by about 5 points.

The board has voted, and two chairmen have volunteered to helm a 2005 Indy Region CenDiv Series Solo2. We are looking for a third chairman for the event, and event specialty chiefs for the event You'll have lots of help, as evidenced by the folks who come out of the woodwork to help with these CenDiv events. If you'd like to participate in CenDiv activities, and provide a major boost to the Indy Solo2 program, please contact either Darren, David, Raleigh Boreen (wiznby@yahoo.com), or Rick Swarts (crracing73@aol.com) to let your intentions to help out be known.

So here's some questions to think about for next year: Should the handling of novice participants be changed? We currently have a novice award, based on the fastest PAX novice of the event. Should we allow a novice subclass, with a different PAX, for each class? That would mean there would now be THREE sub-classes for each class – the straight class, the novice sub-class, and the ladies sub-class. That becomes a bulky juggernaught to administrate, adds more car letters for even more chance to get on-course radio communications wrong, and adds 1/3 more trophies without contributing more money to pay

for them. Possibly a better idea would be renaming the Ladies class for the Indy region, and allowing novices to enter that. Maybe we could



call it "Handicap" Class, or maybe "Index" Class. Let the Solo2 chairs know your position on this topic.

About Solo2 Sites for 2005: I ran a Rantoul regional event a few weeks ago, and that is a GREAT SITE! But, it's about 2 hours from I-465, just a bit longer trip than Grissom. Would Indy region folks drive to Rantoul for an series points event? What if it were a co-sponsored Indy-CIR event? Let the Solo2 chairs know what you think about this idea.

I urge those of you that have email to sign up for the Indy SCCA Yahoo email group to receive the latest updates and information. There are different contact options available so that you can choose to receive individual emails, digests, or special notices only. It's a relatively low volume list and it is a great way to keep in touch with the latest news about the Indy Region. It takes the dedicated efforts of Co-Chairmen, Event Chairmen, Event Specialty Volunteers, and an Uncredited Cast of Thousands (well, maybe not that many) to pull off our events, so please step up to give back! We will be posting the names of those that have volunteered to be an Event Chair along with the Solo Schedule in each issue of Clutch Chatter and on the website. It's easy to volunteer - just contact us!! Solo Events without a designated Event Chair will be cancelled. Remember - this is YOUR club!



Clutch Chatter Mailing Opt-In/Opt-Out

Indy Region implemented the '**opt in' approach** for mailing Clutch Chatter with the April 2002 issue. Unless you sent in the 'opt in' form (below), you will not receive a copy in the mail.

A complete, printable, electronic format copy of Clutch Chatter (including back issues) in Adobe pdf format is available to view or download on the Indy Region website at indyscca.org.

When an issue of Clutch Chatter is completed and ready for publication, the pdf file will be posted out on the Indy Region website and a **special notice e-mail** will be sent to the Indy Region e-group with a link to the download page. This should be available several days before the mailed copies arrive, since it won't have to go through the printer or the mail.

In order to receive this special notice e-mail, you will need to be a member of the **Indy Region e-group**. Membership in the e-group is free and open to anybody, plus it's very simple to join. Just go to one of the following links and follow the instructions:

http://groups.yahoo.com/subscribe/indyscca http://groups.yahoo.com/group/indyscca

If you want to receive the e-mail notifying you that the new issue of Clutch Chatter is posted on indyscca.org, but you <u>don't</u> want to get all of the other regular e-mails that come through the e-group, you can select to receive only special notices. To change your e-group settings, go to http://groups.yahoo.com/group/indyscca/, then select **Edit My Membership**, then change your **Message select** option to **Special notices**.

You don't have to receive the e-mail to get the newsletter — it will be posted on the website and available for download by anybody. The e-mail will just be letting you know that the new Clutch Chatter is out there.

The **pdf format** is very popular and widely used. It is supported by Adobe Reader, which is available to download for free, commonly pre-installed on new computers, and widely compatible with all but the very outdated versions of Windows. There is a link to the Adobe page on the Indy Region website, too.

New members of Indy Region will receive Clutch Chatter in the mail for three months, after which they are expected to view or download from the website. They will be able to elect to opt-in by filling out and mailing in the form below.
