This is a synopsis of the minutes of the meeting of the Indy Region BOD August 17, 2006 at DOOKZ Sports Grille, 6:30 PM. There were 9 directors and 7 guests present. Minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Clutch Chatter Expenses for the year are still close to the projected budget. August issue was mailed on Aug 1. Dick requested everyone get their material to him by Aug 21 for the Sept issue.

Website John reported that our website host has set up new servers with improved connections, should experience fewer outages than before. This will help John in posting pictures and results for the members.

Membership Current membership is 525 members. Raleigh and Velma suggested a spring mailing to all the non-member competitors from the previous year to alert them of the upcoming schedule(s) of events. Everyone thought this is a great idea. Dick Powell has the listing of non-member competitors through the year, and will compile the list in the spring.

Rally We have a rally scheduled for Sept. 24; Cheryl is working on the route and the name. She will get the info to Dick and John for publishing as soon as she can.

Chuck Hanson reported on the National Rally in Kentucky. We had 5 National and 5 Regional entries, which is about average for National Rallies this year. Chuck said all the National Rally Competitors were very positive response to the photo trophies, thanks to the efforts of John Wilmoth in preparing the template and trophies.

Solo Raleigh and Velma Boreen thanked everyone who

helped with the preparations and working for the CenDiv Solo at Grissom. Thanks to a lot of hard work and careful planning, the event basically broke even with total entries for both days at 218. Driver response to the course designs was exceptionally positive. Many Thanks to Raleigh, Velma, and co-chairman Jack Banker, for another very successful CenDiv Solo for Indy Region.

Darren reported da Bus behaved nicely for the Grissom event. The Lafayette Square Mall Solo for Aug 27 is progressing nicely, and we are expecting a good turnout and another successful weekend.

Race Steve Linn has approached O'Reilly Raceway Park at Indianapolis (formerly known as Indianapolis Raceway Park, and remembered that way by all us old fogies) about getting a fourth date for Road Racing next year, expecting to have another region promoting and getting the sanction. Nothing solid yet, but seems to have some potential.

Ralph Porter questioned why we are not set up for online registration for our races. This and the ability to pay at the track with credit cards seems to be mentioned frequently by a lot of drivers. Steve indicated we haven't really pursued the possibility, but we should look into it for next year. We may be able to set up something like the online registration we had for the CenDiv Solo, but will need further investigation.

New Business Next meeting scheduled for Thursday, September 14 at DOOKZ. Meeting was adjourned.

Runoffs Qualification Explained

The Runoffs are the SCCA Amateur Championships, with the best drivers from the 8 Divisions in each of the 25 classes competing for the title National Champion. This is an Invitational meet, and the drivers must meet certain qualifications to get the invitation.

The Driver must have qualified for 4 National Races in the year, and Finished 3 of them. At least 2 of the races must have been in the drivers Division of record. A driver who finishes within the top 10 in points, but does not have the required 4 starts, does not qualify for the runoffs. A driver could be 5th in points on only 3 races. Without the 4th race, he is not eligible for the runoffs.

The Driver must be in the top 10 in points in his Division, counting points from no more than 2 out of Division races, and must accumulate a minimum of 4 points. Points are awarded for finishing First (12 Points), 2nd (9), 3rd (7), and decreasing 1 point per position from 4th thru ninth. Only the Drivers best 6 finishes are counted for the points total.

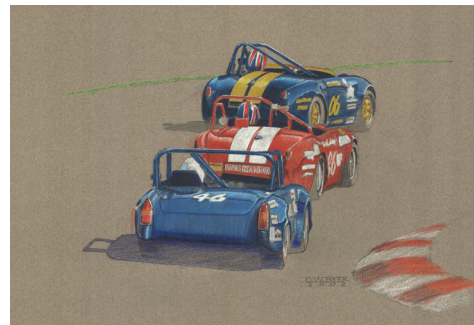
