



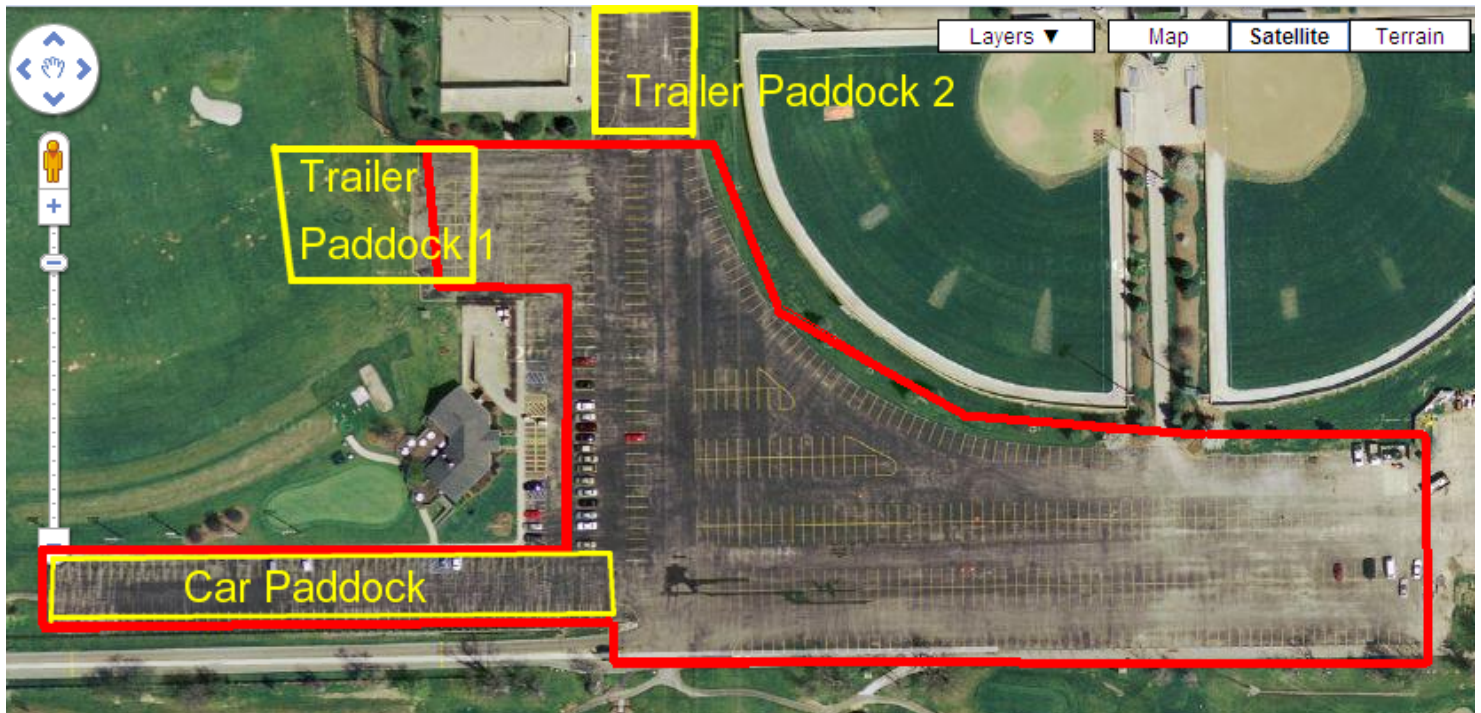

Well it is the middle of July our race has been successfully held; the National Tour at Grissom 4th of July weekend was a huge hit. I'm only sorry I had to miss it. For those who did not know and the reason for my absence the last couple of months is I got laid off in February. I was hired by an airline to work out at the airport in May right after our race weekend. Since then I have been traveling for training and getting settled into my new position and the hours.

Now we are back to work and ready to tackle some challenges facing the region for the future. First, is the state of our race program. While many have signaled the demise for ORP that **could not** be further from the truth. While I will admit and concede the facility is no longer viable as a venue to host a National Race. ORP is still viable as a facility to host a Driver's School or even a PDX. It could also still be possible to host a Regional there with some modification to the Pit Lane/False Grid and Paddock area that would require some thought and planning to make happen.

Before I was elected I proposed the creation of a Competition Board for the region to oversee the Race Program. Including uncovering available talent to be part of a pool for the Race Chair position, and developing new venues to hold races at. To this end I have asked Dave Dusterberg to step in and head the project. Thankfully he has agreed. We have opportunities to visit other venues in Michigan and Kentucky to host races. I have also asked Steve Linn to approach Putnam Park one more (and final) time to inquire about the possibility of our return to their facility.

Our Solo program is on solid ground and the Rally program is making strides forward and is growing. Both divisions display the strength of our region. Our Race program needs to regain the stature it once held, and that will be our focus for the rest of 2009 and into 2010. In order for us to accomplish this we need your help. Whether it is volunteering to assist in the Competition Board or for duty in a race weekend everyone's assistance is needed. This includes not making statements publicly that cause us (the BOD or Comp Board) to refute what was said with what is the truth.

A case in point is during the National Weekend I spent a large amount of time dispelling the rumor that ORP was done. A decision has not been made regarding that issue on our part and for a member or members to speak for the region with out the knowledge or approval of the BOD is not acceptable! In fact it went so far track personnel asked me about it on Sunday. NOT GOOD! The rumor may have actually done us more harm than good with the track. But that is yet to be determined. So please refrain from making any statements about the status of ORP.

Club Race/ Steering Committee Meeting

The Region's first Club Race Steering Committee meeting was held on July 14th. Seven members attended the meeting with representation from racers, the Board of Directors, and interested volunteers.

The meeting got under way with some discussion of the stated goals for the committee. Those goals are:

- 1) Seek and develop new "talent" for the Race Chair position.
- 2) Recruit and develop members interested in becoming Specialty Chiefs (i.e.:Registrar, T&S, Start, Hospitality, etc.
- 3) Assist in the planning and staging our race weekends.
- 4) Develop new venues for the race program while maintaining relationships with current venues.
- 5) Develop a "Master Plan" for our own facility.

Ideally this committee would consist of 7 members with one being a Region Board member, and one Driver Representative. There

is no experience necessary other than the desire to be involved and to further develop our race program.

The conversation then turned to a discussion of current and potential future venues. Much of the conversation centered around the challenges presented by the current state of our traditional venue, O'Reilly Raceway Park. From there the Committee discussed other potential venues such as Bluegrass Motorsports Park, Gingerman Raceway, and Putnam Park.

The group decided the following actions should be undertaken by the next meeting:

Steve Linn will try to make contact with the Diasos at Putnam Park to see if we can forge some kind of relationship.

Dave Dusterberg is to make contact with John Peterson, Great Lakes Divisional Steward concerning options for O'Reilly Raceway Park. Dave has also been in contact with Kurt Niemeyer, Sales and Marketing Director for Bluegrass Motorsports Park concerning dates for 2010.

Our next meeting will be held on August 11th at Performance Driven, 4444 Decatur Blvd. Indianapolis Indiana, 46241. Anyone interested in learning more about our Club Race program, make comment, or wish to volunteer are more

Indy Region Solo Program had a busy July. We put on yet another great Solo National Tour event at the Grissom Aeroplex. Organizers Raleigh and Velma Boreen, along with a cast of dedicated volunteers, worked the July 4th weekend from Wednesday to Sunday to pull off the year's largest Tour event to-date.

It was a packed weekend. The Evo full-day school was on Thursday while set-up continued around the site. On Friday the Evo short school led off the schedule, flowing into the test and tune. Both used the same Larry Harts designed short course. And no, it wasn't designed for Larry's short cars. It was a screaming fast course that was a blast to run. Tech and registration wrapped up the day.

Saturday dawned with threatening skies. By about 1pm the rain started in earnest and the rest of the day was soggy. On Sunday it was a whole different story and the day was nice and dry. The courses were well-designed and challenging.

Just shy of 300 drivers participated in the event from 29 states. It ran very well and we received good feedback from the National staff and good press on the forums.

Old Business Loustuff.com proposal for year-end trophies still needs some ideas. Lou Byer will make specific estimates for the next meeting, Dick Powell to help Lou with what is needed. The new communications radios have been purchased, and the rebate forms submitted. Headsets from Annies Attic have been checked, work OK with the new radios.

Treasurers Report Rich emailed the report to everyone before the meeting. The Race Bills have all been submitted and settled, and the race weekend has some surplus.

Clutch Chatter Dave requested everyone to please submit their columns and articles as soon as possible to give Pauletta a chance to get the newsletter out on planned schedule.

Membership Current membership is 465. Phil asked if we are able to tell how many weekend members convert to permanent. Dick said this information is on the member lists from SCCA National Office, available to the membership chairperson.

Activities August Club Nite Out is scheduled for Aug 4 at Shapiro's downtown, September 1 at Cheeseburger in Paradise Northeast.

Rally July Rally has sanction, has been pre-checked twice, is ready to go. August rally is on track, will be ready.

Race Curt Niemeyer at Bluegrass Motorsports Park has been contacted by Dave, looking for dates for 2010. Gingerman Raceway has contacted us to possibly hold a race there next year. Steve Linn will continue working with contacts at Putnam Park.

The first meeting of the Race Steering Committee was held August 14. There were discussions about possible changes for a pit lane at

ORP; If the Divisional Stewards agree as feasible, we will contact and work with ORP for the possible changes. This will necessarily have to be postponed until after the Krogerfest and US Nationals weekends.

Next meeting of the Race Committee will be Tuesday August 11 at Performance Driven.

Solo The new Rallycross Chair is Matt Jordon; he has contacted others to help chair an event. He has completed the first half of the Safety Syeward training. We may possible get a date in September.

National Tour Solo at Grissom went very well, excellent response from competitors and other officials. There were 284 contestants. Club has received some funds for hosting the event.

The Australian Pursuit event only had 27 entrants, were able to have two contests, one in each direction. Everyone got plenty of runs and enjoyed the day.

Replacement of the PA system was discussed, including the FM transmitter. One possibility would be utilizing the FM transmitter and some Boomboxes around the paddock and grid areas, giving extra range without requiring excess audio power. Replacement was included in the budget for the year.

New Business Annies Attic should be cleaned out: plan to move the trailer and goods to Chuck Hansons place, and give Chuck the "rental" that would be paid to Annies Attic. This will actually improve access, and have the trailer in a more central location. Darren will work with Pete Hylton concerning some of the club records and materials currently in the storage location.

Dave Dusterberg submitted a proposal to create a communication chair for the club. This would be a person responsible for getting club information to other media, and getting other items of interest into our own media system. The BOD approved unanimously. Dave will put an ad in CC to try to find someone for the position.

Next BOD meeting scheduled for Monday, August 17 at Dooley O'Tooles. (Editors note: the meeting date has been changed to Monday, August 10). Meeting was adjourned.

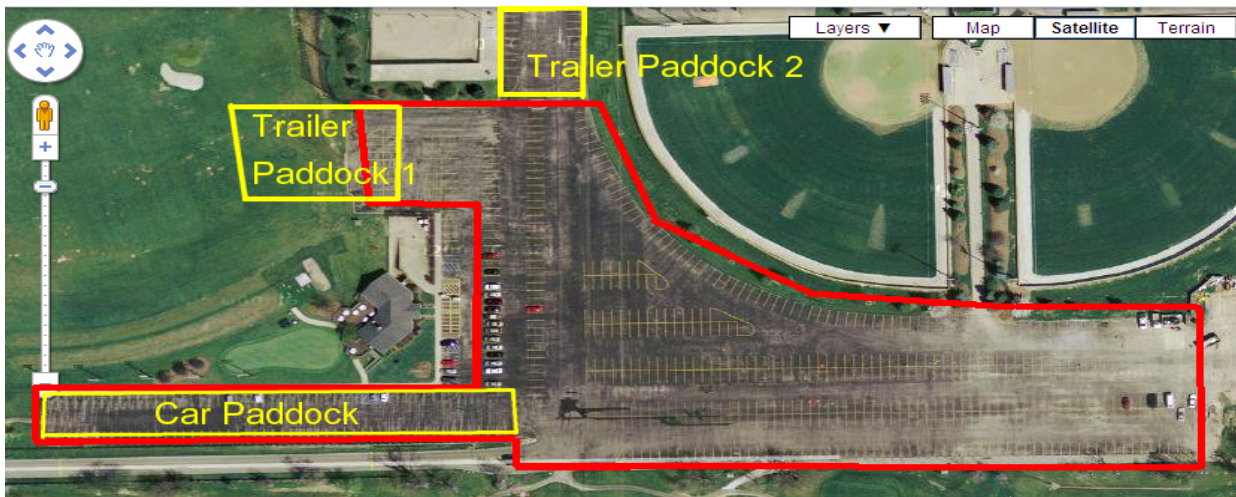

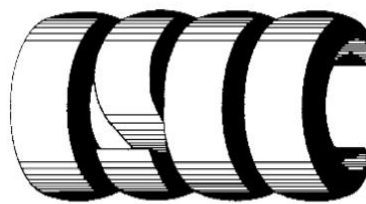
ATTORNEY NEEDED

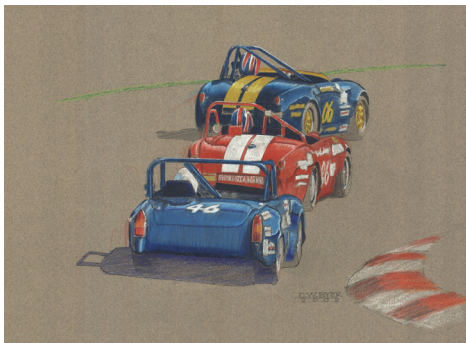
