Old Business

- Solo bus purchased. Temporarily stored at Bob Miller's house
- Region purchased a transponder decoder and 250 ft. of cable from Detroit Region for \$650.00 Rich reports it works well.
- Bryan Deane approved a traveling trophy for Club Race Rookie of the year requested by Steve Linn.

Treasurer's Report

- Paid out: New bus, transponder, Grissom fees
- Copies of 2009 books sent to the accountant.

Clutch Chatter

- Pauletta requested all article submissions be in by the 15th of each month
- Pauletta expressed concern over the lack of paid ads in CC

Website

- John sent an e-mail entailing improvements he made to the website. Many in attendance agreed the improvements were good.

- Scott is looking for an Equipment Chief
- Harold Hammerly has been contracted to build shelving for equipment in the new bus.
- 1/3 of paddock @ Grissom has been lost to a trucking company.
- Solo trophies have been ordered.

New Business

- Membership requested to purchase vendor space at the March Indy Super Swap. Board agreed to purchasing 3 spots and electric for this event.
- Region has been approached by Purdue University to help with training of officials for an electric go-kart race April 28th. Bryan Deane will train volunteers in F&C procedures as well as helping with driver training for students competing in the race. Date of training to be determined.

Old Business Our display at the March Super Swap Meet got some response, but not as much as hoped for. Pauletta suggests we not repeat for next year.

Treasurers Report Rich emailed the report to everyone before the meeting. He is sending the check for the upcoming Rally Sanction(s). Rich has suggested a review of insurance issues for daBus (new) due to amount of bill, which recently increased significantly, possibly due to a different person added as a driver.

Clutch Chatter Deadline for material for next issue is the 15th.

Website John emailed a report before the meeting, read report to attendees.

Membership Pauletta reported current membership is 461.

Activities There were 19 people at the April CNO. May 4 will be at O'Tooles. Pauletta has published the schedule of CNOs for the year in CC.

Rally Ides of March Rally had 15 cars, an excellent turnout. April 17 Rally is ready to run, looking for a good turnout. Charles Lemeron is setting up the first June Rally, a combination Tour and GTA in the NE sector, and is nearly ready for pre checking. Chuck Hanson is preparing the late July Rally, which will be in the SE sector.

The Champaign Sports Car Club has volunteered to run our September Rally, which has been gratefully accepted.

Race We are continuing to follow up on our racing options for this year, and will get information out as soon as we know we are ready.

Solo We had 90 drivers for the Season Starter Fun Run, on a Phil Wehman designed course that was well liked by all. Scott has suggested we have a worker assignment as Security for the parking / paddock area on future 16th street events. Next event is our first points event at Terre Haute on April 25.

Grissom needs some repairs again: Raleigh and Velma are trying to organize a work day for May 8th, and hoping to get some people down from Fort Wayne Region to help also. Larry Harts will be doing the concrete repair work, while others of us do the remaining chores.

Scott has asked about possibly getting a PO Box for the region. We will temporarily use the corporate registered agent address for mail receiving, which Scott now has.

New Business Ft. Wayne Region has contacted Rick Lankford about possibly renting our race timing equipment for a Kart race on August 21. Pauletta is familiar with the equipment setup and usage, and will review the request. At this time, we expect this will be OK for us and them.

Next BOD meeting scheduled for May 10. Meeting was adjourned.

It was also in a geographical area that we have stayed away from for the last several years, so the competitors got to see new country.

Elsewhere are the results of In Search of Old Indiana, and the flyer for the June 6 event. This will be Charles's third event for the Region. He is doing a combination GTA and Tour event. I haven't seen the route, so I can't tell you anything yet. However, since

it is Tour based it will be a whole lot easier than the first two events of the season. (None of that messy trying to figure out where the "main road" goes.) Wendy Harrison and Craig Beidelman went to St. Louis to run a GTA event earlier this month, and won. Judy and I will be in Pittsburgh on April 24 trying another National Course rally, and are planning on a CCSCC event on April 30. Craig and Wendy are thinking about running that before continuing on to St. Louis for another event on May 1. Which brings to mind a semi-famous motto of the rallyist: Discover America – Get Lost on a Rally, or Julie's favorite: Don't Follow Me – I'm Lost Too.

Finally, you will notice that there are several people who are listed as responsible for more than one event in the following calendar. We intend to make this schedule happen, but we could certainly use some help. (We did get a volunteer to take the Sept. 25 date; i.e. the Champaign County Sports Car Club has had so much fun running the Ides of March the last two years that they have offered to do an event for us.) The rules say that to be considered for yearend trophies you need to work an event in a capacity that prevents you from running the event. We would love to have you help us.

Planning a rally is a little bit like planning a party. The preparations are made, the guests are invited and the final wish is that lots of people will attend and have a good time. With this in mind, we were thrilled that among the eight cars (16 drivers and navigators) entered in the In Search of Old Indiana Rally, many of them had not rallied with us before. The next hope was for everybody to have a good enough time that they would come back and rally with us again.

The April 17 rally was a Regional Course/GTA event. This type of rally is often referred to as a "Trap" Rally because of its difficulty. The Course and GTA cars followed the same set of instructions and only executed an instruction when it took them off of the Main Road. Determining which road is the "main road" at an intersection is tricky and, in the case of this rally, many times the main road was the dirt road that left the paved road in the dust. In addition, care was taken by the Rallymasters to ensure that there were two different ways to follow the course – a right way and a, well – "wrong" way. Many teams found their own unique way through the course.

In the short driver's meeting before the rally, we gave everybody limited verbal instruction, armed them with printed General and Route instructions, then set them free to fend for themselves in Hendricks and Boone counties. Scoring was based on how well the course was followed, but there should also have been awards for persistence, sense of humor, sportsmanship, and heartiness – all of which abounded.

In the end, we were thrilled that all of the new entrants took everything in stride and, over a relaxed dinner at Flapjack's in Lebanon, promised they would be back to rally with us later this year. We're looking forward to seeing everybody in June for the next Indy Region rally.

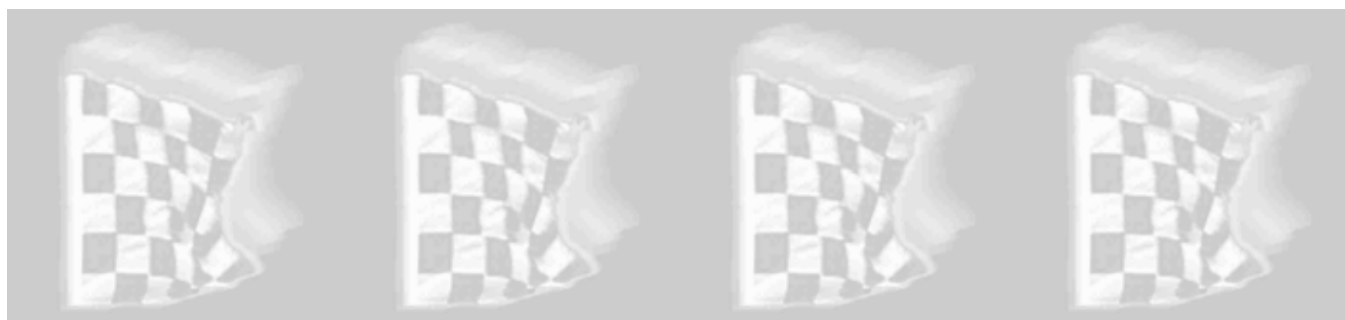
