

# **Indianapolis Region Awards Points Rules for 2012**

## **RALLY CROSS AWARDS**

1. General:

- a. All Indianapolis Region Rally Cross events will be year-end counting championship point rallies unless otherwise noted. "Non-point" rally cross events such as fun events will be clearly advertised as such.
- b. Year-end championship awards will not be awarded unless the region conducts a minimum of three points events.

2. Classes of Competition: Classes of competition on points events will be determined by the rally cross chairman. The classes will be drawn from one of the following three(3) groups:

- a. Group I Stock
  - 1. Rear Wheel Drive (SR)
  - 2. Front Wheel Drive (SF)
  - 3. All Wheel Drive (SA)
- b. Group II Prepared
  - 1. Rear Wheel Drive (PR)
  - 2. Front Wheel Drive (PF)
  - 3. All Wheel Drive (PA)
- b. Group III Modified
  - 1. Rear Wheel Drive (MR)
  - 2. Front Wheel Drive (MF)
  - 3. All Wheel Drive (MA)

3. Member's Qualified Points: A determination of a member's qualified points for a year-end championship award will be accomplished or effected by the following:

- a. A member's best finishes in 75% of the region's declared points events or best 6 finishes, whichever is less, will be counted toward a year-end championship award. Note! - A 75% multiplication factor resulting in a .5 event will be rounded up. Example: 6 events x 75% = 4.5 = 5 events to be counted toward an award. Otherwise, events will round up to nearest whole number.
- b. Points will be counted only for Indianapolis Region members. Anyone who joins on or before September 1<sup>st</sup> in a given year will receive points for those events run as a non-member. Anyone who joins after September 1<sup>st</sup> in a given year will receive points only for events run after joining the Indianapolis Region.
- c. The member must compete in one given class in a minimum of three (3) or 50% of the region's rally cross points events, whichever is less. (Round up for odd number of events).
- d. Members must qualify their points by working one Indianapolis Rally SCCA event or seek work agreeable to the Rally Cross Chairman, i.e., pre-checking, acting as safety steward. The Rally Cross Chairman will be responsible for keeping a record of those people who have fulfilled the work requirement towards year-end point eligibility.

Points schedule:

4. Publication of Points:

- a. The rally cross chairman will be responsible for tabulating and publishing the points.
- b. At a minimum, the current points standings will be printed in the regional publication before the next to last scheduled points event.

5. Year-end Awards: Year-end awards will be determined per the following format:

- a. Year-end awards will be awarded to competitors earning the highest points totals by class.
- b. Competitors eligible to receive awards in more than one class will receive them only in the class giving them the highest year-end finishing position. If the competitor's season ending point totals are the same in two classes, they will receive an award in the higher ranked class. Classes will be ranked in order as follows: Modified, Prepared then Stock.
- d. Ties for year-end awards will be broken on the basis of quality of finishes; i.e., number of firsts, seconds, etc.

e. The number of awards presented in each class will be per the following awards schedule:
