Secretary's Report: Del Bartlett

June 10th BOD Meeting Minutes, McAllister's Deli on Crawfordsville Road, Speedway, IN

A quorum being present, with proxies, the Regional Executive, Charles Tashiro, called the meeting to order at 1835 in the reserved guest room of McAllister's Deli located at 5822 Crawfordsville Road, Indianapolis, Indiana.

Others attending were: Chuck Hanson, Lee Miller, Sam Crites, Mickee Miller, and Kurt Richter (Rally USA)

The minutes of the May 13, 2025 Board Meeting were offered for approval by RE Tashiro, and upon motion, second and discussion, were approved unanimously.

I. Officer Reports:

- A. RE Tashiro thanked the Board members for their assistance in organizing and providing documents for the pending AG Investigation Response.
- B. ARE Daubenspeck proposed an addition to the Agenda to include a discussion of the Vitour Sponsorship proposal. He reviewed the various benefits to the club including payment terms that had been negotiated with Dallas Reed, (Vitour Representative), as well as award procedures and certification redemption. Specifics regarding "Track Records" for the TT program were discussed by several BOD members. He recapped the actions necessary if the contract is approved. Following his report, he recommended that the corporation entered into the agreement with Vitour which will be effective for the balance of calendar year 2025. ARE Daubenspeck then moved for Board approval that the corporation sign the Vitour contract. Following second by Director Nienhouse, the motion was approved with no opposing votes or abstentions.
- C. Treasurer Report: Treasurer Lawrence was not in attendance so the Treasurer's Report was given by RE Tashiro. He reported the Treasurer is refining a program to more easily monitor disbursements.
 1. ARE Daubenspeck requested 2025 spending progress on each approved budget, and to know if any program has exceeded their spending limit. Access to view the accounting line item spreadsheets per approved program, and for any spending not on an approved budget was also requested.
 2. RE Tashiro recited the present bank balance and noted the balance did not reflect the pending payment due to the Putnam Track.
 3. Treasurer Lawrence agreed to obtain corporation bank account records from Huntington Bank for the period prior to establishment of the corporation account with PNC.
- D. Secretary Report:
 1. Secretary Bartlett agreed that he would contact Michael Young for his input into identifying account purchases requested by the AG.
 2. Secretary Bartlett then advised of the assistance needed to comply with the AG's requests.
 3. ARE Daubenspeck moved for approval of a budget to cover the expenses of the corporation's compliance with the State AG investigation request, to reimburse the Secretary for copying supplies and postage expense incurred in responding. The motion to reestablish the budget in the amount of \$400.00 was seconded by Director Harrison, and following discussion, the motion passed by majority vote with the Secretary abstaining.
- E. Membership Report followed showing total membership of 555 with 19 weekend, 27 new and 18 expired.
- F. Road Rally Report was given by Director Harrison.
 1. She reported no registrations for the upcoming event on Saturday.
 2. Director Decatur has created a page for the event to be held July 5 between Bloomington and Bloomfield, Indiana.
- G. Time Trials Report was given by RE Tashiro, (today is his birthday).
 1. He reported that 68 attended the Nationals last month and though it was a great event, expenses of \$2,800.00 exceeded revenue by \$100.00.
 2. Next year, he proposes that the corporation collaborate with Putnam or Mid-Ohio, but not National.
 3. He reported events are scheduled at Putnam on August 2 and 3, and August 8 at Mid-Ohio.
- H. Solo Report was given by Director Neinhouse.
 1. Nationals are to reimburse expenses for the Grissom National Tour Solo of \$3,851.00 and there were 173 total entries at the event.
 2. He reported the corporation is on budget with respect to Solo events.
 3. He suggested the corporation may want to consider setting aside a fee for replacement of the 2000 bus used for Solo events. He advised there are very reasonably priced used buses available.
- I. Rally Cross Report was given by RE Tashiro. He reported the June 16 test event has been canceled, and the rain date of July 13 may not go. It will be a closed event, entrants by invitation only.

- II. Old Business. Mickey and Lee Miller reported an MP at Grissom came to the gate during the May 31 - June 1 event and inquired about drone activity. Apparently, it was unrelated to any club activity. There being no new business, upon motion, second and discussion, the meeting was adjourned by a majority vote at 2030.

Solo Chairman Report: Charles Nienhouse

Hi all! Three more Indy points events are now in our rear-view mirror. Points 3 & 4 were well attended despite the heat and high humidity. Thanks to all that came out to turn up the heat another notch! One thing that I really like to pay attention to is the top PAX scores. For those not familiar, the PAX system was SCCA's method of scoring cars together from a wide variety of classes by applying a multiplier to their times. Even though PAX has been replaced by the Racer's Theoretical Performance index (RTP), the term "PAX" is still used. While the PAX (RTP) system is not liked by everyone it is the only way we have to compare the results from all the different classes in an apples-to-apples sort of way. Having said that, I'd like to congratulate the top PAX scorers from Points Events 3 & 4. On Saturday Chris Shieldsmith was the top scorer driving his A-Street Porsche Boxster. On Sunday Kevin Keys took the top score with his CAM-S Corvette. Congrats to both!

The next event, Points #5, was the annual Indy-Columbus Shootout held at the Indiana State Fairgrounds. I think we set some sort of record for the number of drivers that showed up! This year the event was shifted to the "West" parking lot across 38th Street due to the degraded surface inside the horse track and it appears this was a positive move. After a full day of tough competition three Indy drivers and three Columbus drivers earned their way into the final Shootout. They were Nikhil Khopkar, Vinnie Taibi, Kevin Keys, Jae Hun Choi, Kevin Berba, and Darren Daubenspeck. When the smoke cleared it was Nikhil Khopkar that finished with the highest score and went home with the Shootout trophy.

Notes from the Director's Chair

Area 4 Director Update for July 2025

July has the CRB and BoD face to face meetings in Kansas City and the CRB is working hard to prepare for the Runoffs at Road America.

I've been asked by Frank Schwartz (divisional Club Racing points keeper) to alert the membership about a couple of things. One, the GLDiv points are now stashed in the cloud. Go to the GLDiv site, choose Programs and then Road Racing. When the page loads, choose "Click here for current points standings". You'll find the spreadsheet there. Two, decals are required to participate in the Regional Championship Series (RCS). These decals should be available at the track. Check with the folks in Tech. If you have any questions, please drop an email to Frank and he'll help you out.

Here's what I did since my last report.....

Video Conference Meetings:

- Club Racing Board (CRB) (6/3): The group discussed SMX at length. The sealed engine idea has been turned into a "What do you think" (WDYT) and will be sent to the populous in the next Fastrack. SMX data reports were reviewed. The FSRAC will be conducting a survey of FV drivers about a tire rule. Once again, we continued the discussion on the agenda for our upcoming face to face meeting in Kansas City. We also chatted about the preparation for the Runoffs. 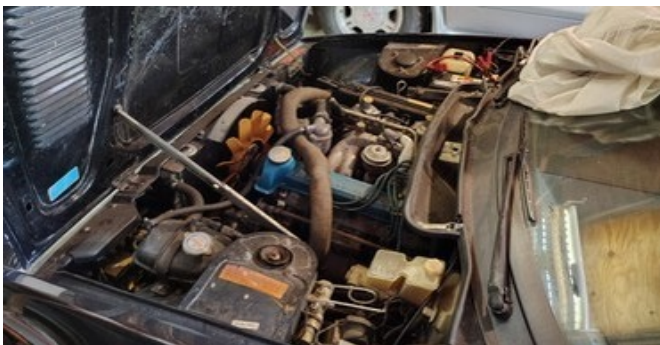

Was last assembled incorrectly, so the push rods bent. Up-rated engine. Lower end is probably OK. No sleeves.
